ENG 099 Instructor Feedback

- ☐ You can prepare students BEFORE the 101 gets there.
- ☐ Coach them more individually, particularly on research and prewriting.
- ☐ Talk openly and freely about their out-of-class performance. Are you reading? Why or why not?
- ☐ It has been an ideal way to intervene hands-on with the students in ENG 101 who are most at risk for failure.

ENG 099 Instructor Feedback Continued

- ☐ I have the freedom to change my daily assignments, grades, grading structure, etc.
- ☐ This course absolutely, positively must be small in number. I think twelve is too large and would cap it at eight.
- ☐ The trick for developing a good ENG 099 is to build your ENG 101 separately; then think of all the things you wish 101 students knew for each unit.
- ☐ The class helps to let students know that I am on their side, trying to make them better writers.

ENG 099 Instructor Feedback Continued

☐ (This instructor had an ENG 099 between two sections of ENG 101.) The students who just came out of the 101 class in the morning are able to preview things and speak about things that the afternoon 101 students will encounter. In this way, you give students the opportunity to inform each other and ask questions of each other. Then, when those afternoon students go to the 101 class, they actually are prepared in a deeper way to understand what happens there.

Coreq Do's and Don'ts

The same instructor should teach both courses if possible. If not, then the two instructors MUST communicate FREQUENTLY.

Plan ENG 101 first; then create your coreq course to anticipate and meet needs of ENG 101.


Coreq course is NOT just a lab or study hall.

Coreq course should have a plan, but it is not a rigid, standalone course. Be prepared to scrap your daily plain to respond to student concerns, both academic and nonacademic.

Keep coreq enrollment in ENG 101 below 50%.

Schedule coreq before, between, after ENG 101 on the SAME DAY.


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
